Sub: Request for Arranging Fortnightly Rectification Camp to help Dealers rectify the GST refund claims held up due to technical errors.

Respected Sir,

Greetings from Gujarat chamber of Commerce & Industry, Ahmedabad.

We are the apex body of all the Chamber of Commerce of the state of Gujarat and is a 70-year-old Non for-profit entity being founded by the Stalwarts of Industry of India, we represent interest of around 6000 direct member and nearly 2.5 lacs indirect members through membership of Regional Chambers and Trade associations based in Gujarat.

Industry is thankful to the Govt. of India and its secretariat for Implementing this GST tax reforms across India in such a short span of time, though the intention of Govt. of India is pro-Industry while forming various acts and rules to collect revenue for the government by means of Indirect tax like GST.

However, there has been instances of problems faced by the Industry in claiming GST refunds particularly in cases of IGST and CGST due to technical errors like mismatch in SB006.



Earlier, the council used to have a fortnight meeting with the dealers to rectify such errors and thus was paving way in clearing the GST refunds.

We therefore once again request the council to initiate this arrangement once again so that the dealers who are facing technical errors while claiming GST refunds be head off and a solution to the industry is presented with.

Please find attach a representation that we have received from one of our Trade Member, whose members are facing such issues and their letter written to the Chairman of GST Council vide letter No. GDMA/GST/335/2019 dated 29th June, 2019.
