Sub: Request to provide exemption to industries manufacturing agricultural inputs in view of the lockdown due to COVID-19

Dear Sir,

Greetings from Gujarat Chamber of Commerce and Industry (GCCI).

We greatly appreciate the timely measures taken by the government with a view to minimize the impact and spread of COVID-19 in the state. It is only due to such efforts that we have been able to combat this deadly epidemic till now.

Sir, due to the complete lockdown imposed in the state, some industries manufacturing essential commodities or the inputs required for such essential goods or commodities have also been facing problems in manufacturing, import, logistics and retailing of these products.

One such example is that of the units manufacturing agricultural inputs (such as seeds, pesticides, feedstuffs, fertilizers, cleaning agents used in agricultural products' manufacturing, food additives, implements machinery etc.) which are not being allowed to continue their operations and logistics in the state due to the lockdown.

Sir, we are passing through extremely testing times and in such a situation it is critical to ensure the uninterrupted supply of essential items and services. The farmers are greatly dependent on such inputs for their production which in turn is essential to ensure food security during especially during this period.

The state governments of Karnataka, Telangana, Jammu and Kashmir, Punjab and Haryana have already taken a decision to exempt the production and logistics of these agri-inputs manufacturing industries in their respective states.

Sir, we request that similar relaxation should be provided in our state too so during this lockdown period. We are confident that you will consider our request sympathetically and take a positive decision in the matter.

CIRCULAR

Sub :- Agriculture Dept.- COVID-19 - Epidemic Disease Act -1897 –
Lockdown Orders- Procurement, Processing and Movement of
Seeds, Fertilizers and Pesticides- Certain guidelines issued – Reg.

The WHO has declared COVID-19 (Corona Virus) as a Global Pandemic. In the reference 1st cited, the Govt. of Maharashtra, has communicated multiple restrictions and social distancing as proactive measures and to observe State wide lockdown to prevent onset of community transmission of Corona virus. The Govt. of India has ordered for continuation of State lockdown across India for 21 days starting from 25th of March 2020 vide circular cited at sr. no. 3. The said notification states that, manufacturing units engaged in production of essential commodities may function and will also be permitted to operate. Shops/establishments providing essential goods and services shall be excluded from the above restrictions which include:

1. Supply chain and transport of essential commodities.
2. Exports and Import of agricultural goods and products and all commodities.

The Seed and Fertilizers are essential commodities within the meaning of the Provisions of Essential Commodities ACT, 1955. With the reference no.3 cited above, the Government of India has also included pesticide in the sub-clause (a) of Clause 4. In this connection, the following guidelines are issued in support of continuation of production, processing and supply chain and transportation of seeds, fertilizers and pesticides in the State of Maharashtra.

A. Seeds :

- The harvesting season of seed crops start from February to May months across all crops.
- The harvesting, post harvest operations, shipment of raw seeds and packing activities of all seed crops is in peak across the State and from other state/states.
- Presently Soybean, Hybrid Maize, Sorghum, Forage Crops, Pearl Millet, Cotton, Pulses, Rice, Groundnut, vegetable Seeds etc. are in

movement from production locations to processing plants across the State and from other states.

- Seed Storage, testing, processing, grading and packing, R&D etc., are now in full swing and going on across the State.
- State seed requirement is to be procured during the months of March, April, May and June and this period is very critical to do all back-end process to ensure timely supply of seed during Kharif 2020 season.
- Raw seed of major seed crops is to be lifted for storage, testing, processing, grading and packing. Processed seed is to be dispatched to stock points/godowns.
- Allied industries like packing material, seed treatment chemical suppliers and distributors and dealers are also very important in supplying the seeds to the State.
- All the Seed Companies are hereby directed to take all suitable measures and safe guards while handling the seed and see that seeds of all crops produced by the Seed Companies are supplied to farmers during Kharif, 2020. The Companies are further informed that no hoarding of the Seeds shall happen in the State. All the processed and packed seed must be made available to the farmers well before the onset of monsoon.
- The companies are directed to follow the below mentioned essential safeguards.
 - There shall be no congregation of more than 5 persons in any processing / storage units while performing their duties.
 - A social distance of at least 3 ft shall be maintained from person to person.
 - Proper sanitation shall be ensured in all premises where labour/persons/staff are working in seed processing/storage units.
 - Sufficient provision of masks/sanitizers/hand washers shall be made available.
 - All the seed companies shall make payment of wages /salaries fully to the workers,/employees during the lock down period.
 - The staff and workers working in the seed companies are permitted to move to the extent required for carrying out their job responsibilities. The identity cards issued by the company employing them can be used for ascertaining their identity.
- The vehicles carrying the seeds from farmers' fields to the processing plants and from one processing plant to other processing plant and to the distribution points (C&F agencies) or from distribution points to the retailers are permitted after due inspection based on the accompanying documents which clarify that they are nothing but seeds or the packing materials, leaflets, treating materials etc., required for packing the seeds.

B. Fertilizers and Pesticides :

Keeping in view of Guidelines forwarded by the Govt. of India for ensuring continuous movement of fertilizers in the reference 2nd cited and fertilizer being an Essential Commodity, the following guidelines are issued in support of operations for timely warehousing and movements of fertilizer within the State and from other state.

- Fertilizer/Pesticide manufacturing units can be kept in operation by taking all precautions of social distancing of three feet, proper sanitization, sufficient provision of Mask/Handwash/Hand sanitizer etc. Also there shall be no congregation of more than five person at a single place while performing their duties.
- Fertilizer Manufactures/Companies are directed to take all suitable measures in placing the indents with the railways to ensure continuous supply of fertilizers required to the state for Kharif, 2020 and to monitor the supplies with reference to indents placed on real time basis.
- The Companies are further directed that necessary measures shall be taken up through their dealer networks for timely availability of fertilizers to farmers and not to resort for hoarding/black marketing.
- There shall not be any restrictions on the movement of fertilizers & Pesticides and their raw material required for production from one place to other place within the state and from other state which depends on crop season and local demand.
- All the stakeholders involved in the fertilizer rake operation hamals, lorry crew, labour hired for loading and unloading operations, etc. shall continue the operations following adequate safety measures to protect from Covid-19.
- Fertilizer & Pesticides dealer shops shall remain open and continue functioning. The buyers shall be advised to maintain 3 feet distance while purchasing the stocks.
- Dealers are requested to provide hand sanitizers and ensure hand sanitization by the buyers before and after Bio metric authentication.
- All goods vehicles carrying the Essential Commodities like fertilizers & Pesticides shall be allowed to ply during the lock down period in the state.

C. Warehousing:

Warehousing Corporations are also part of storage and distribution of agriculture commodities such as seeds, fertilizers, manures, pesticides, agricultural implements and notified commodities. Hence, warehousing activities relating to seeds, fertilizers and Pesticides are permitted to continue in the state duly following the safety measures as detailed below during the lockdown period.


- All the Corporations shall make payment of wages /salaries fully to the workers,/employees during the lock down period.

- There shall be no congregation of more than 5 persons in any units while performing their duties. A social distance of at least 3 ft shall be maintained from person to person.
- Proper sanitation shall be ensured in all premises where labour/persons/staff are working in Warehousing units.
- Sufficient provision of masks/sanitizers/hand washers shall be made available.

All the Seed, Fertilizer and Pesticide companies are directed to follow the above mentioned directions/guidelines without any deviation otherwise suitable action as per existing laws / Government orders will be taken.

All the above activities including movement of seed, fertilizer and pesticides needed to be carried out by the institutions/functionaries including dealers concerned should be permitted to function during the lockdown period by concern district authorities as per guidelines of Government orders cited above.

In view of above, the Offices charged with Law and Order and Magisterial Duties are requested to implement the circular instructions for the welfare of farming community of the state.
