**Sub : Queries for Labour License**

Greetings from Gujarat Chamber of Commerce and Industry.

Gujarat Chamber of Commerce and Industry (GCCI), founded in the year 1949, is the apex trade and industry body in the state of Gujarat representing all cross sections and segments of industry and trade across the state of Gujarat. GCCI has more than 4000 direct members and 200,000 indirect members through various Regional Chambers & Associations affiliated with us.

As per the ordinance dated 20<sup>th</sup> July – 2020, the minimum strength required for obtaining labour license has been changed 20 to 50. Our members have raised some queries with regard to process of obtaining labour license which are as under.

1. If an establishment (Contractor) is having multiple contracts with one Principal employer with separate work-orders (with different form 5 for each contract) and different period of commencement and conclusion dates in the same premises of the Principal Employer, should he have 1 common license or separate license for each contract?
