Sub: Request to reduce the GST rate applicable for Health Insurance.

Respected Madam,

Greetings from Gujarat Chamber of Commerce and Industry (GCCI).

Madam, currently GST rate of 18% is applicable on health insurance premium which is similar to the tax rate charged on luxury items. At a time when the Government is making huge efforts to promote health and well-being among the citizens, taxing health insurance at a rate similar to luxury items does not seem rational. Further, health insurance has become a necessity for the citizens in view of unexpected pandemics and illnesses such as the recent Covid-19 pandemic.

In consideration of the above facts, we would request you to provide following GST related relief in the health insurance sector:

- 1. The GST rate applicable on health insurance premium should be reduced from 18% to 5%.
- 2. Senior Citizens should exempt from GST on health insurance.
- 3. Under Section 80-D, the current maximum limit of Rs.25,000 on health insurance should be increased to Rs.1,50,000 and for senior citizen it should be increased to Rs. 2,00,000.
- 4. Small sized health insurance such as micro insurance should be exempted from GST.

We look forward to your positive consideration of our above requests.
